Dr Duprey is also a highly accomplished therapist who uses a range of therapeutic approaches, such as Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), Video Interaction Guidance (VIG) and Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing (EMDR). Dr Duprey has particular expertise in working with children, young people and adults with neurodevelopmental difficulties, such as autism spectrum disorders and learning disabilities. This includes providing specialist diagnostic assessments.
