Dr Jennie Duprey is a Chartered Clinical Psychologist, registered with the Health and Care Professions Council and an Associate Fellow of the British Psychological Society. Dr Duprey currently works as an independent psychologist, providing assessments, intervention, training and supervision. Dr Duprey has supervised assistant, trainee and qualified psychologists and currently mentors psychologists who are new to working within the Family Courts. Dr Duprey has been providing psychological assessments for the Family Courts since 2012 and is experienced in attending Court to provide oral evidence. She has been highly commended by a Judge who stated in their summing up of a case that she gave considerable weight to Dr Duprey's evidence due to her knowledgeable, rigorous, balanced, and compassionate approach to providing evidence.

Dr Duprey's core areas of expertise focus on three areas: 1. The psychological assessment of and intervention within families in which there are child protection concerns. This includes assessing parental risk, parenting capacity and the impact of mental health and/or learning disabilities upon parenting, as well as the impact of trauma, abuse and neglect on a child's development. 2. Providing evidenced-based psychological interventions with children and adults following traumatic experiences, including homicide, developmental trauma and childhood abuse. 3. Working with children, young people and adults with neurodevelopmental difficulties such as autism spectrum disorders and learning disabilities. This includes both specialist assessments as well as interventions around challenging behaviour.
